AN INTERDISCIPLINARY EXPERIENCE IN POLAR STUDIES

In celebration of the IPY 2007-09 year, this 3-week course will focus on environmental change in the Arctic and Antarctica through a series of lectures and field excursions in Svalbard, Norway. The course will cover topics on Glaciology, Geology, Meteorology, Oceanography, Marine/Terrestrial Biology, Permafrost, and the Human Dimension in Polar Regions.

Eligibility Applicants should be Undergraduates or early Masters students, with a minimum of 1 year in physical/technical and/or natural sciences.

Cost A 200 Euro course fee, and your travel costs to UNIS located in Longyearbyen, Svalbard. Food & accommodation are included in the course fee, and will be due upon acceptance to the course. The estimated cost from Oslo to Longyearbyen is 380 Euro. There are some travel grants available for those students that require financial assistance.
